

BEACONS (FAROS) Fallas Trails



1 BEACON OF TAÜLL

DIFFICULTY
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From Taüll (1,520 m), head past the village's last houses on the road towards Pla de l'Ermita. A steep trail leads to Torresplanes at 1,760 m, one of the best viewpoints in the Boí Valley. Perched above the landslide area known as "Esvomegada" of Sarradé, this climb offers sweeping views of the entire valley.

2 BEACON OF BOÍ

DIFFICULTY
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Starting in Boí (1,265 m) at Riu Square, head south along the path. After 200 m, take the left-hand trail that climbs to the beacon on Clotet d'Escudé Rock at 1,460 m. Overlooking the path connecting Boí and Durro, this spot provides a stunning panoramic view of the valley.

3 BEACON OF ERILL LA VALL

DIFFICULTY
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From Erill la Vall (1,245 m), start at Tarter Square and follow the Basco Trail. At the beginning of the climb, turn right onto a steep path leading to the beacon at 1,410 m, situated between the Ribampieder Ravine and Palomero Mountain. This beacon offers an exceptional view of the village and serves as a great vantage point for the valley.

4 BEACON OF BARRUERA

DIFFICULTY
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In Barruera (1,097 m), cross the old bridge, turn right, and a few meters ahead, take the left path onto the Els Quinyons Trail. Follow this through the forest to the beacon, located on Tossal de Rutxero at 1,230 m.

5 BEACON OF DURRO

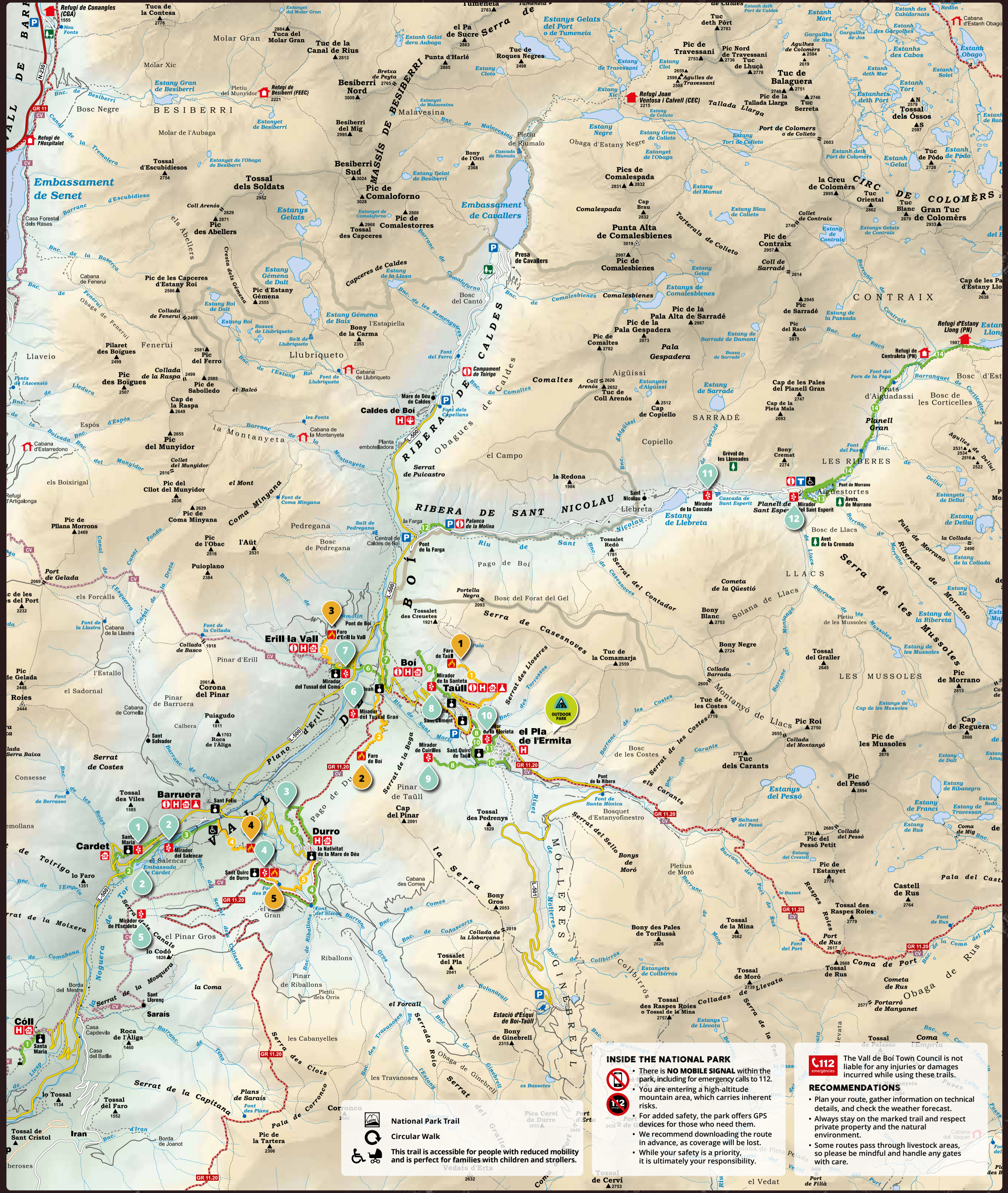
DIFFICULTY
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From Durro (1,386 m), cross the village and follow the track towards the Sant Quirc Hermitage, a UNESCO World Heritage site. At the far end of the hermitage, you'll find the beacon at 1,490 m, offering spectacular views of the valley.

National Park Trail
Circular Walk
 This trail is accessible for people with reduced mobility and is perfect for families with children and strollers.

INSIDE THE NATIONAL PARK
 There is **NO MOBILE SIGNAL** within the park, including for emergency calls to 112. You are entering a high-altitude mountain area, which carries inherent risks. For added safety, the park offers GPS devices for those who need them. We recommend downloading the route in advance, as coverage will be lost. While your safety is a priority, it is ultimately your responsibility.

RECOMMENDATIONS
 Plan your route, gather information on technical details, and check the weather forecast. Always stay on the marked trail and respect private property and the natural environment. Some routes pass through livestock areas, so please be mindful and handle any gates with care.

For centuries, these paths have been used by people and livestock traveling between villages. Walking along them offers the chance to enjoy breathtaking landscapes, a variety of wildlife, and vibrant plant life. 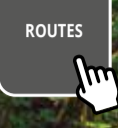
THE VIEWPOINTS OF VALL DE BOÍ A Valley at Your Feet

ROUTES



1 ROUTE TO THE CROSS OF TÈRMINO DE COLL

DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 0.70 km

🕒 25 min.

⬆️ 90 m

A pleasant, easy walk starting in Còll, the trail follows cobblestone paths, crosses a small ravine, and leads to the stone cross. From this spot, enjoy wonderful views of Còll. The cross features a hole that's perfect for framing the church and capturing a memorable photo!



2 ROUTE FROM BARRUERA TO CARDET

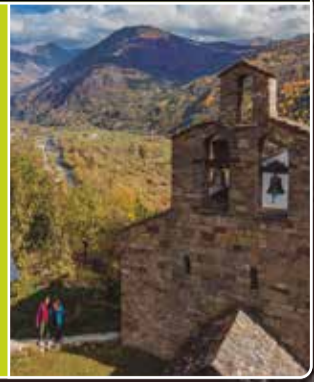
DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 2.20 km

🕒 50 min.

⬆️ 100 m

Starting in Barruera (1,097 m), beneath the Church of Sant Feliu by the river, the route follows the right bank of the river (south) towards the dam along a paved track. When the track ends at the L-500 road, cross it and continue along the path that follows the mountain slope, leading directly to the Church of Santa Maria de Cardet (1,197 m). To return to Barruera, take the path near the viewpoint, descending along the ravine back to the L-500 road near the Cardet Dam (1,088 m). From there, you can either return to Barruera via the Water Trail or continue towards The Sarais Bridge.



3 SALENCAR OF BARRUERA

DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 6 km

🕒 110 min.

⬆️ 1 m

We leave Barruera (1,097m) from the playground next to the river and take the walk along the right bank of the river to the dam following the paved track. We return and cross to the other side of the river via the suspension bridge and continue to the humid area of Salencar where we can see the pond, the bird observatory and the viewpoint.

4 ROUTE FROM DURRO TO SANT QUIRC DE DURRO

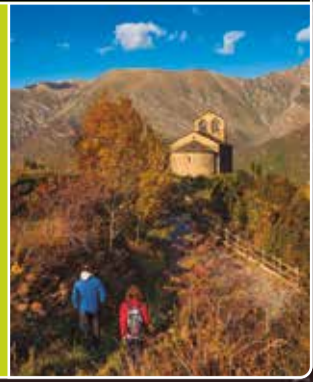
DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 1.80 km

⬆️ 114 m

From the car park at the entrance of Durro (1,380 m), head towards the Church of the Nativity. To the left of the church, continue to the village square, then walk straight through the village, following the path to the Hermitage of San Quirc de Durro (1,494 m). There's also a more accessible option via the paved track leading to San Quirc.



5 ROUTE TO RACÓ DE DURRO

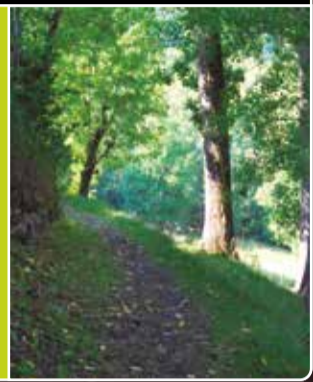
DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 0.70 km

🕒 25 min.

⬆️ 90 m

We leave from Durro parking, follow the road and 100 m to the left we will find the Matas Path that will take us to the Racó viewpoint. From there we go up to Capella de Marquès to connect with the Pago Path that will take us back to Durro.



6 ROUTE FROM BOÍ TO ERILL LA VALL

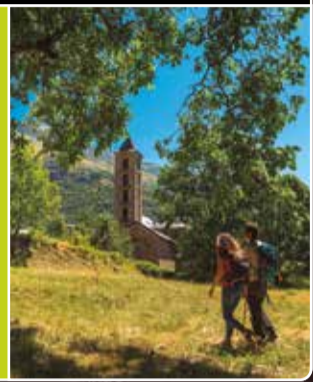
DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 0.95 km

🕒 25 min.

⬆️ 40 m

Starting from Boí (1,265 m), begin at the car park below the church and follow the trail through the fields until you reach the bridge over the Noguera de Tor River. After crossing, head up for about 100 metres, then cross the road and take the path that leads directly to Erill la Vall (1,247 m).



7 ROUTE TO LAS ROQUETAS BOÍ

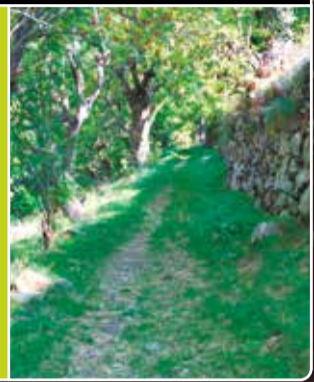
DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 1.20 km

🕒 20 min.

⬆️ 45 m

Starting from Boí (1,265 m), head to the northern end of the village and take the right-hand street, opposite the way down to the village car park. Walk past a few buildings and follow the path until you reach the L-500 road, where you can connect to the Caldes de Boí Trail. Alternatively, before reaching the road, you can take the Llançeros Path that leads to Taüll.



8 ROUTE TO CUIRILLES TAÜLL

DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 1.90 km

🕒 30 min.

⬆️ 50 m

From the car park in Taüll, follow the route to Pla de la Ermita. At the fork, take the right-hand path that descends, cross a river via a bridge, open and close a livestock gate, then continue on to the viewpoint.



9 ROUTE TO LA SANTETA TAÜLL

DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 1.20 km

🕒 15 min.

⬆️ 95 m

Starting at Santa Maria de Taüll Church Square (1,508 m), walk around the church and continue straight along the street. After a small incline, you'll find the entrance to the footpath of La Santeta, which leads to a stunning valley viewpoint.



10 ROUTE FROM TAÜLL TO PLA DE LA ERMITA

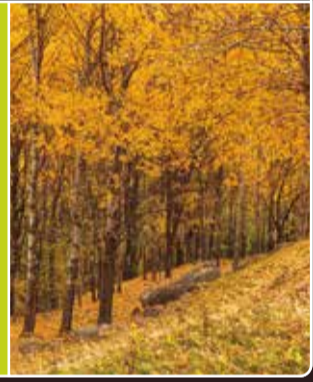

⬆️ 128 m

From the Taüll car park, take the trail along the San Martí Riverbank towards Pla de la Ermita. Upon reaching a large meadow, follow the track to the left, which leads to Pla de la Ermita (1,618 m).



11 ROUTE FROM PLA DE LA ERMITA TO SANT QUIRC DE TAÜLL

DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 0.50 km

🕒 15 min.

⬆️ 0 m

From the gravel car park at the entrance to Pla de la Ermita (1,623 m), take the path on the right. It gradually leads you to the Hermitage of San Quirc de Taüll.



12 ROUTE OF THE LOVERS

DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 0.60 km

🕒 25 min.

⬆️ 70 m

Drive towards Caldes de Boí and park at La Farga car park, located on the left side of the L-500 road at the entrance to the Aigüestortes National Park. From the car park (1,315 m), cross the road just before the bridge over the San Nicolau River. The trail follows the river to the Molina Bridge car park.



13 AIGÜESTORTES PLATEAU

DIFFICULTY
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○-○ 1.50 km

🕒 60 min.

⬆️ 0 m

The route begins at the taxi car park in Planell de Aigüestortes and follows a forest track. After a few meters, cross the Morrano Bridge and continue along a 450-meter boardwalk leading into Planell de Aigüestortes (1,825 m).

This trail is accessible for people with reduced mobility and is ideal for families with children or strollers.



14 FROM AIGÜESTORTES PLATEAU TO LAKE LLONG

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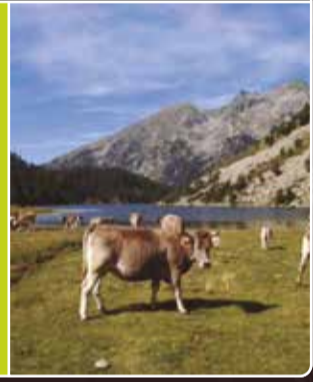

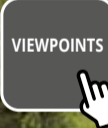

The route to Estany Llong (2,000 m) follows the course of the San Nicolau River, passing through Planell Gran and the Aiguadassí meadows.

NOTES
To reach Planell d'Aigüestortes (1,822 m), you can take the public transport from Boí or walk, starting the hike from La Molina Bridge.



VIEWPOINTS



1 CARDET VIEWPOINT BARRUERA

This accessible viewpoint sits beneath the striking apse of Santa Maria de Cardet, one of the valley's most remarkable sights. Perched on a steep mountain slope, the church was ingeniously designed to incorporate the incline, featuring a small crypt inside—the only one in the entire Romanesque collection of Vall de Boí. From here, you can take in the stunning views of Barruera and the entire natural landscape of Salencar.

2 VIEWPOINTS OF SALENCAR BARRUERA

CARDET DAM VIEWPOINT
Follow the river's right bank from Barruera towards the dam, and you'll come across a viewpoint near the dam offering fantastic views of Barruera.

SALENCAR VIEWPOINT
A trail from the Salencar pond leads to a viewpoint with a bench, offering the perfect spot to pause and enjoy the diverse flora and fauna of this natural area.



3 RACÓ VIEWPOINT DURRO

This viewpoint offers excellent views of Barruera, the Salencar area, the grounds around Caldes de Boí, and the mountains of the national park.



4 SANT QUIRC VIEWPOINT DURRO

Accessible by a hiking trail or a paved road from Durro, this is one of the valley's best viewpoints, offering stunning panoramic views. From here, you can see nearly all the villages, from Còll to the Cavallers Dam. It can also be reached by taxi or authorised vehicles. This point has a Starlight viewpoint that allows you to contemplate an exceptional night sky.



5 LA ESCALETA VIEWPOINT DURRO

Follow the path from Durro toward the Sant Quirc Hermitage. From the hermitage, continue along the forest track until you reach a fork in the road. Take the right-hand path and follow it to the Escaleta Viewpoint, about an hour's walk away. From here, enjoy breathtaking views of Cardet, Còll, Llesp, and the mountains of El Pont de Suert. An information panel at the viewpoint helps identify the peaks before you.



6 TUSSAL GRAN VIEWPOINT BOÍ

Located just 15 minutes from Boí, along the trail connecting Boí and Barruera, this spectacular viewpoint offers a serene retreat in Vall de Boí. From here, take in magnificent views of Aüt and the Caldes area, with Erill la Vall directly across the valley. This spot is also a great place to rest along the Barruera-to-Boí hike, with nearby fitness equipment for a quick workout.



7 TUSSAL DEL COMÚ VIEWPOINT ERILL LA VALL

From Baix Square in Erill la Vall, take the path opposite the magnificent Church of Santa Eulàlia. This route leads to a viewpoint at the crossroads of several valleys. Here, you can enjoy panoramic views of the ski station, Boí, Taüll, Pla de l'Ermita. To the north Aigüestortes National Park, as well as the Caldes de Boí Spa. To the west, take in the charming valley of Erill la Vall. This viewpoint is the perfect spot to admire the valley's grandeur and peaceful beauty.



8 LA SANTETA VIEWPOINT TAÜLL

Just a 15-minute walk from Taüll, starting at the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Church of Santa Maria, this easy trail leads to a viewpoint with a breathtaking panorama of the valley. Enjoy views of Boí, Erill la Vall, Barruera, and the elevated village of Cardet at the valley's end. An information panel helps identify the landmarks in sight.



9 CUIRILLES VIEWPOINT TAÜLL

Around 30 minutes from Taüll, this trail offers stunning views of the village and the surrounding majestic mountains, evoking a sense of being "where the Pyrenees touch the sky." Two benches along the way provide a perfect spot to relax and soak in the scenery.



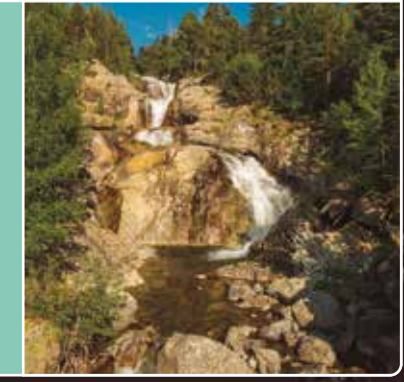
10 LA GLORIETA VIEWPOINT PLA DE L'ERMITA

This delightful viewpoint is just a short walk from the Pla de l'Ermita car park. Its charming wooden pergola adds a unique touch to the sweeping views of the valley's mountains and the picturesque village of Taüll.



11 LA CASCADA VIEWPOINT

From the Palanca de la Molina car park, follow the trail towards the Planell d'Aigüestortes. After passing Lake Llebre, you'll come upon the awe-inspiring San Esperit Waterfall. The trail continues to a viewpoint directly in front of this impressive cascade.



12 SANT ESPERIT VIEWPOINT

Located in the Planell d'Aigüestortes, this viewpoint can be reached by 4x4 taxi, a two-hour hike, or by bike. It features an information panel to help you identify the surrounding mountains. From here, admire the Llacs valley, with peaks like Morrano and Bony del Graller, as well as views of Lake Llebre, the San Nicolau Valley, and Aüt Mountain.
